**DETERMINATION – EXEMPT AQUATIC ACTIVITY**  
*Clause 18A Marine Safety Act 1998*

Please be advised your proposal regarding Lasershoot on Sydney Harbour from 21 February, 2026 to Saturday, 20 February 2027 has been considered and determined to be an exempt aquatic activity, which does not require an aquatic licence from Transport for NSW.

This assessment and advice have been provided based on the following:

1. The activity is conducted in full compliance with all applicable marine legislation.
2. The activity is conducted in accordance with all details supplied to Transport for NSW.
3. The conduct of the activity will not restrict the availability of those waters for normal use by members of the public or vessel operators.
4. The conduct of the activity will not cause an increased risk of danger to the public or vessel operators.
5. The activity organiser must comply with any direction given by an authorised officer.
6. The activity organiser must at all times ensure compliance with the applicable provisions of the rules and/or regulations under which the event is conducted.
7. The activity organiser is to ensure that any required permission/s of the owner/occupier/manager of the land and/or waters (including government and local government authorities) intended to be used, has been obtained.
8. The activity organiser will postpone or call-off the activity if the conditions under which the activity is to be conducted, including weather and waterway conditions, are or become unsuitable.
9. Prior to commencing activities on any given day within the period noted above, contact is to be made with Sydney VTS and NSW Marine Area Command to notify them of the times (duration) and location of each activity.

## **Reminders**

I take this opportunity to remind you that all incidents on navigable waters involving a fatality, serious injury and/or damage over \$5000 must be reported to Transport for NSW within 24 hours using a Vessel Incident Report form available on the Transport for NSW website.

This advice relates only to the activity specified above and does not apply to the same or similar activities conducted at different times or locations (whether by yourself or by another event organiser). You should seek further advice each time you plan to hold an activity. An aquatic licence may be required - dependent for instance on whether other aquatic activities are planned for the area which may impact on your activity and/or the waterway generally.

All events that require exclusive use of a NSW waterway will need an aquatic event licence.

In accepting this advice, you warrant that you expressly and unreservedly indemnify Transport for NSW from all liability associated with the activity and release Transport for NSW from any actions of any nature that may be instituted in relation to the activity.
